Dear Dixie District Parents,

Please retain this letter for the duration of the current school year.

Due to weather, power failure, or road conditions, it may become necessary to close one or more of our schools. We will keep each school open as long as we have power, no significant flooding or damage, bus transportation is operating, and students and staff are safely able to reach schools. The decision on whether or not to close schools will be made by 7:00 am each day.

The Superintendent will activate the SchoolMessenger service, our school-to-parent communications service the night before or morning of an anticipated weather problem to alert parents of a decision to close a school/s. A message will go to all contact numbers and emails listed on your emergency contact form.

Also, you can call your child's school after 7:00 am to hear a tape recorded message if schools are closed. Here are the numbers to call for the taped message:
